



## PRESENTATION FOR HOPE & HEALING

Millie Lace, MSE, LPC and her husband Dail Lace are the founders & directors of Concepts of Truth, Inc., a professional counseling and care pregnancy center in Wynne, Ark. Born and raised in Eastern Arkansas, the couple has been married since 1974. Millie, a former Jr. High science teacher and school counselor and Dail a retired Army NGO were inspired to establish a non-profit tape ministry in 1998. The ministry opened as a professional counseling and care pregnancy center in 2001 and established the National Helpline for Abortion Recovery in 2003. The confidential, 24/7 National Helpline for Abortion Recovery is a call center that refers callers to local support groups, mails packets of resources and follows up with each caller. Thousands have called from all 50 states, Canada, Puerto Rico and Germany. Concepts of Truth, Inc. also originated *The Pastor's Guide to Heal Our Nation* in an effort to educate and equip pastors and churches to embrace those wounded by abortion. Concepts of Truth is an interdenominational, Christian organization.

Dail & Millie's abortion story was recently included in the devotional book, ***Sisterhood of Faith: 365 Life-Changing Stories about Women Who Made a Difference*** by Howard Books and ***Real Abortion Stories, edited by Barbara Horak***. Also, Millie testified as an expert witness and entered excerpts from the National Helpline to the S. Dakota Legislative Task Force, conducted workshops at the United Nations and presented at the Watchmen on the Wall Pastor's Briefing in Washington, D.C. Millie has served as the Arkansas state leader for Operation Outcry and is also past president of the Arkansas Mental Health Counselor's Association. Millie is a speaker, singer & songwriter who is active in her profession and passionate about her work and her love for Jesus Christ. Dail is active in working with the center's continuing development of the National Helpline, pastor relations and business administration. Millie and Dail have appeared in the TV program Faces of Abortion which airs on the SkyAngel network nationally and on numerous radio programs. The couple has ministered to colleges, churches and youth groups. Their testimony reveals the truth about abortion, the shame that silences women, men and families and the hope for healing and reconciliation. The couple are members of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wynne, AR.

The presentation addresses the psychological effects of post-abortion trauma, hope for healing and the role of the local church. 1 out of 4 American women will have an abortion by age 45. At 45 yrs. of age or older, the number rises to 43% or almost 1 out of 2. (statistical source: Guttmacher.org) **Participants will be educated, equipped and empowered to become pro active for this life issue and reach an untouched mission field.**
